

Frequently Asked Questions:

Is there a cost?

There is no cost, however, you will be responsible for all needed gear, water, food, etc.

Where will we be camping?

We will be camping near the West Clear Creek Trail head off of Forest Road 142E. It's about a 2 hour drive from Prescott. See attached map.

Are there bathrooms and showers?

No, this is rustic, dispersed camping with no toilets, showers, or running water or hook ups for RV's.

Do I have to stay the whole time?

No. Please come for as long or as short as you'd like (you can even stay into Monday if you'd like).

What do I need to bring?

Every person camps differently, this is a suggested minimum. Sleeping bag. Tent, tarp, or RV. Enough food and water for your stay. Extra clothes (check the weather before you leave). Small first aid kit. Camping chair. Toiletries. Flashlight. Water bottle. Bible. Positive attitude.

How old does my son(s) need to be?
